

PENNSYLVANIA DEMOLAY

DeMolay Clubs (Issued 6-29-00, Revised 02-25-04)

The Executive Officer of Pennsylvania has authorized the establishment of DeMolay Clubs, made up of a group of Active DeMolays and trained and certified Advisors in a locality where a Chapter is not currently established. The primary purpose of such Clubs is to work toward the establishment of new Chapters in areas currently not served by another Chapter. In general, and unless otherwise provided in writing, all rules, regulations, and policies governing local Chapters shall also apply to DeMolay Clubs. Advisors in a DeMolay Club must be certified and registered through the Executive Officer, and must be in a 1:5 ratio with members at any activity, also adhering to the minimum of 2 advisors. Active DeMolays in such a club must be members, in good standing, of a properly chartered Chapter of DeMolay, or at-large members, in good standing, of Pennsylvania DeMolay or another recognized jurisdiction. Individuals must notify the Executive Secretary of their intent to meet and to form a DeMolay Club prior to beginning said club.
