

PENNSYLVANIA DEMOLAY

Who May Attend Tiled Meetings (Issued 03-01-03)

In June of 2001, the *DeMolay International Rules and Regulations Section #318.9 (d)*: were amended to read:

The father, mother, stepfather, stepmother, or legal guardian of a DeMolay and any other individual permitted by the Executive Officer may, after giving a pledge not to reveal the secrets of DeMolay, visit a tiled Chapter or witness any of the secret work.

In Pennsylvania, "any other individual permitted by the Executive Officer" automatically includes any adult family member, schoolteacher or administrator, local government or law enforcement official, or member of the clergy. Additionally, any other adult over the age of 21 years may be invited by the consent of a Chapter's Advisory Council. Siblings (brothers, sisters) of members who are not adults are NOT permitted to attend inductions or tiled meetings, unless they are members of the Order.
